Greetings Esperanza Area,

We began December with a Bank Balance of \$3860.94 in our checking account. We made contributions of \$667.27 and paid expenses of \$3228.36. We took in \$2561.09 less than we spent. Our Ending Bank Balance \$1299.85. There are no outstanding checks.

The Treasurer over donated \$128.95 to Tejas Bluebonnet Region for the year 2025, due to lack of understanding of our policy last January 2025, when he donated 5% of the 1st quarter

available funds rather than 5% of December available funds. He anticipated it would work itself out over the year but it did not due to low balance available monies in September and December. We did however make a one-time donation of \$1500.00 to our Region in August of this year.

We have unpaid Obligations of \$100.00 to Rise Recovery for November and December ASC rent. We have not received an invoice due to a change in our URL and subsequent email account. Treasurer hopes to remedy this situation at today's meeting, we also owe Crestholme Presbyterian Church 3 months ASC rent totalling \$375.00 for a check we paid with on an account that was later closed. They will only accept cash from us now.

Fede, Zoom, and Rise Recovery are still unaware of our email change at this writing therefore we are not receiving their invoices. The treasurer will endeavor to contact them during business hours.

Frolic and Activities Facilitators will need to be added to their respective accounts at Frost Bank. This can be done with minutes from our Record Keeper/Secretary and a visit to Frost Bank by the Treasurer or other Executive Committee member currently listed on our accounts. Account signers on most of our accounts need to be updated to remove previous outdated signers and add current signers.
