Greetings Esperanza Area,

We began January with a Bank Balance of \$1299.85 in our checking account. We made contributions of \$2073.43 and paid expenses of \$1408.98. We took in \$664.45 more than we spent. Our Ending Bank Balance is \$1964.30 as of January 31st. There are no outstanding checks.

Contributions in January were from a return of seed by the Literature Sub-Committee and the Kerrville Group. This was because icy roads compelled us to meet remotely via Zoom. Copies of last month's Treasurers report are on the table along with this month's report.

We have no donation to RSC in February because our "Actual Funds Available" for January is a negative - \$469.95. See line 18P on the Excel spread sheet.

Treasurer will file with the IRS for tax year 2025 before the end of March.

As of this writing on 2/6/26, an audit of the Treasurer for July through December 2025 has not been completed. It is planned to be held at Rebekah's home and we will audit EACNA 11 at the same time.

The Area Facilitator and the Treasurer are working together to get the correct people on the Frolic, Activities, and Literature bank accounts.

Treasurer has updated all of our vendors with our correct URL and email in order to receive invoices. If anyone is receiving a bill for Esperanza please update them with the treasurer's email treasurer@esperanzana.org. I cannot pay it if I do not have an invoice.
