Greetings Esperanza Area,

We began March with a Bank Balance of \$3374.14 in our checking account. We made contributions of \$4378.77 and paid expenses of \$1557.23. We took in \$2821.54 more than we spent. Our ending Bank Balance of \$ 6195.68. There are no outstanding checks.

Contributions in March were much higher than usual due to the donation from EACNA 11 of \$3442.48

Treasurer has signed a month to month Lease Agreement with Public Storage for a 10x10 facility. The lease is to the Esperanza Area with the Treasurer name (Tommy H.) listed as the Fiduciary. The ASC Co-Facilitator is listed as a secondary contact to the Landlord. The key from the previous 5x9 works to open the new 10x10 unit. If you have a key to the unit that you needed for a previous Service position, and no longer need it to be of service, please return it to the Treasurer. Treasurer has given a key to the Frolic Facilitator and has 2 extra keys.

All of the items from the old unit are in the new one utilizing 50% of the space available. Those items are labelled and are Archives of the Recorder, Treasurer, and supplies used by our Activities Sub Committee. There is painters tape and a Sharpy for marking items and a tape stripe down the middle to encourage responsible storage etiquette. 😊 Thanks to the volunteers that helped with the move.

Did you know we only have 217 days left until EACNA XII. We had our first ESF on 4/18. This event was a huge success, we have not got the final count on the exact numbers but we did have great unity and an atmosphere of recovery happening. We sold many shirts and have a few left if anyone wants one today. We also have duffel bags for sale which were a huge hit. Committee meetings will be held on the first Tuesday of each month, the next one being on Tuesday 3/5 at 7pm, 8900 Starcrest. We are gearing up for another great year this year. The hotel link is ready and we also have set the price for the banquet and pre-registration is on line as well. Please book your rooms as soon as possible.

I do want to speak briefly about the proposal that is to be voted on today. Obviously, we are against having the convention every two years and the understanding is that this is due to rising cost. This would be a false assumption; cost did shoot up right after covid and we were getting room rentals at \$10,000. Last year we got them at \$8,000. This year they came down \$3,000. So, we are trending in the right direction and hotels are willing to work with us. Even when cost did rise, we found a way. We found a way and NEVER passed any expense to the fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous or to the addicts. We have NEVER had to cancel or delay convention because we did not hit our room block, we found a way. There is also talk that we are “taking away” money from this area. I am here to tell you that all monies raised for this convention come from the previous years convention or through our hard work on ESF's. We have given so much back to this area and are always happy to do so. I am confident that prices will continue to go down and that this AREA convention will do what we have always done, throw a life saving convention that promotes unity and fellowship at a minimum cost to the addict who still suffers, we will love on and encourage the newcomer, We will carry the message, We will find a way.
