Our expenses totalled out at \$1,750.10 bringing us to an ending bank balance of \$9,629.16. Quarterly regional donations are based on actual funds available at the end of June, which is 5% \$6,087.34 = \$304.37 donation to be made to the region. 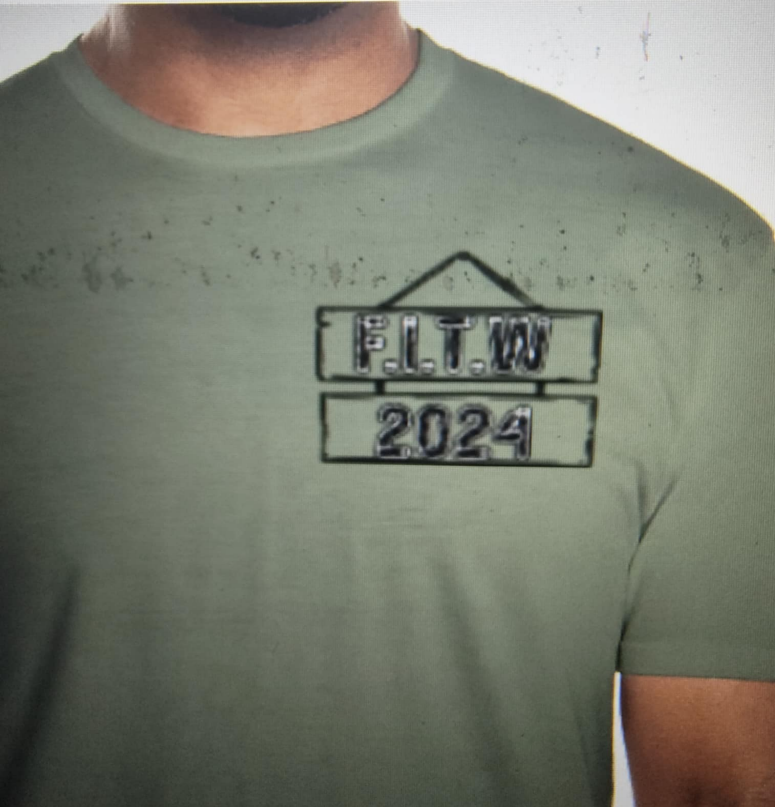


